



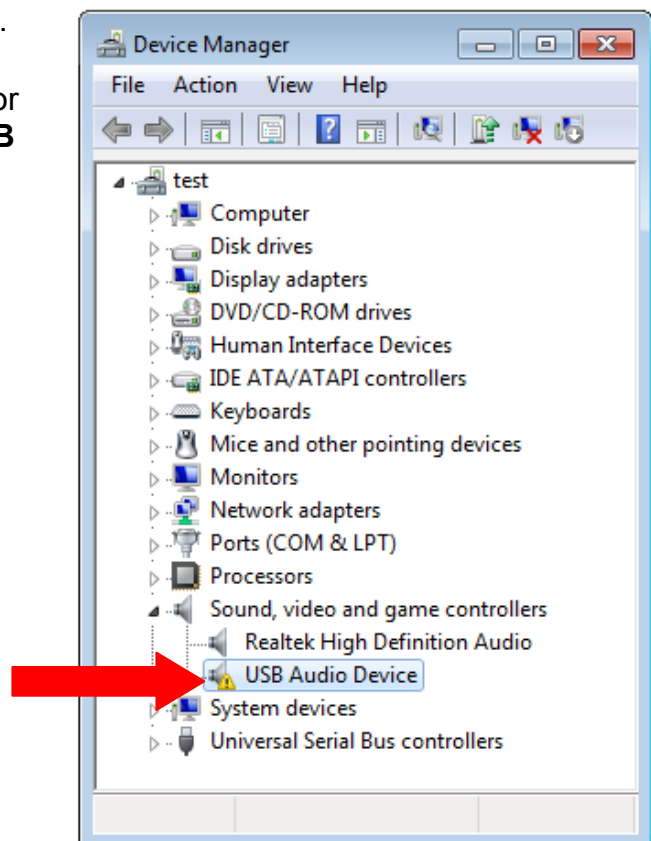

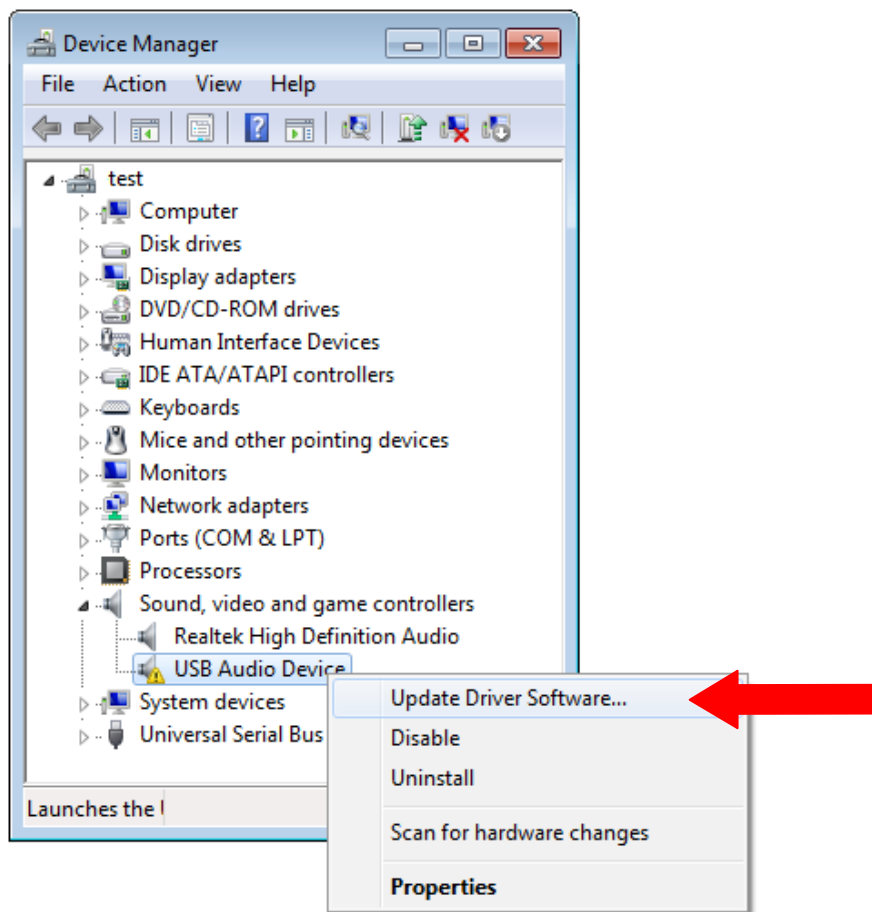
DRIVER INSTALLATION

WINDOWS VISTA, 7

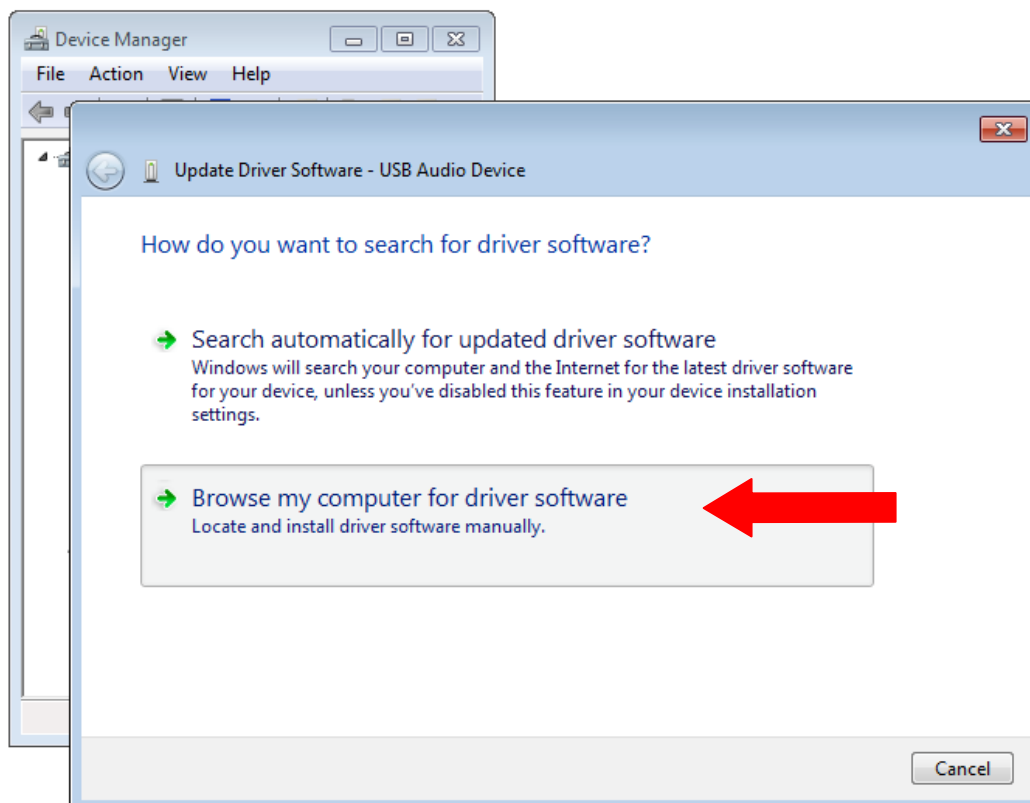
- 1 Download the newest driver package from the Internet and copy and extract the files to your computer
- 2 Connect the controller to your computer.
 - Open the device manager and search for “Audio, Video and Game controller “**USB Audio Device**”. An error indication is shown in front of the corresponding element.



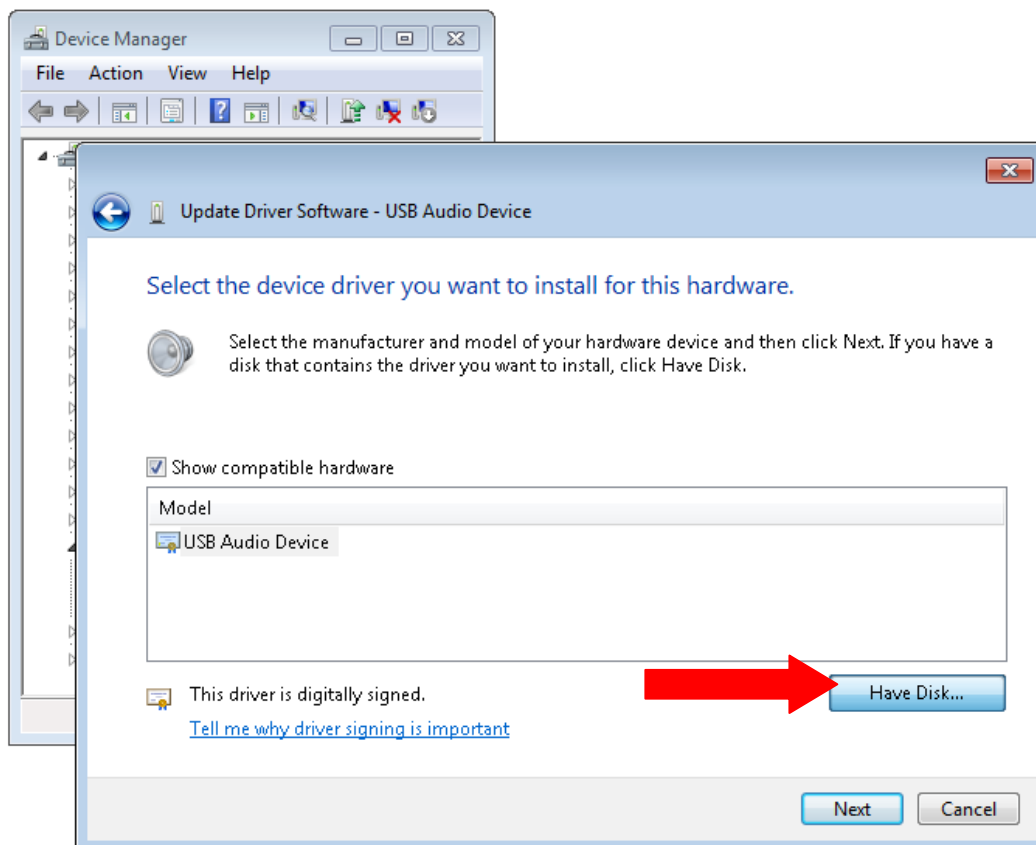
- 3 Right-click USB Audio Device and then left-click “**Update driver software...**”.



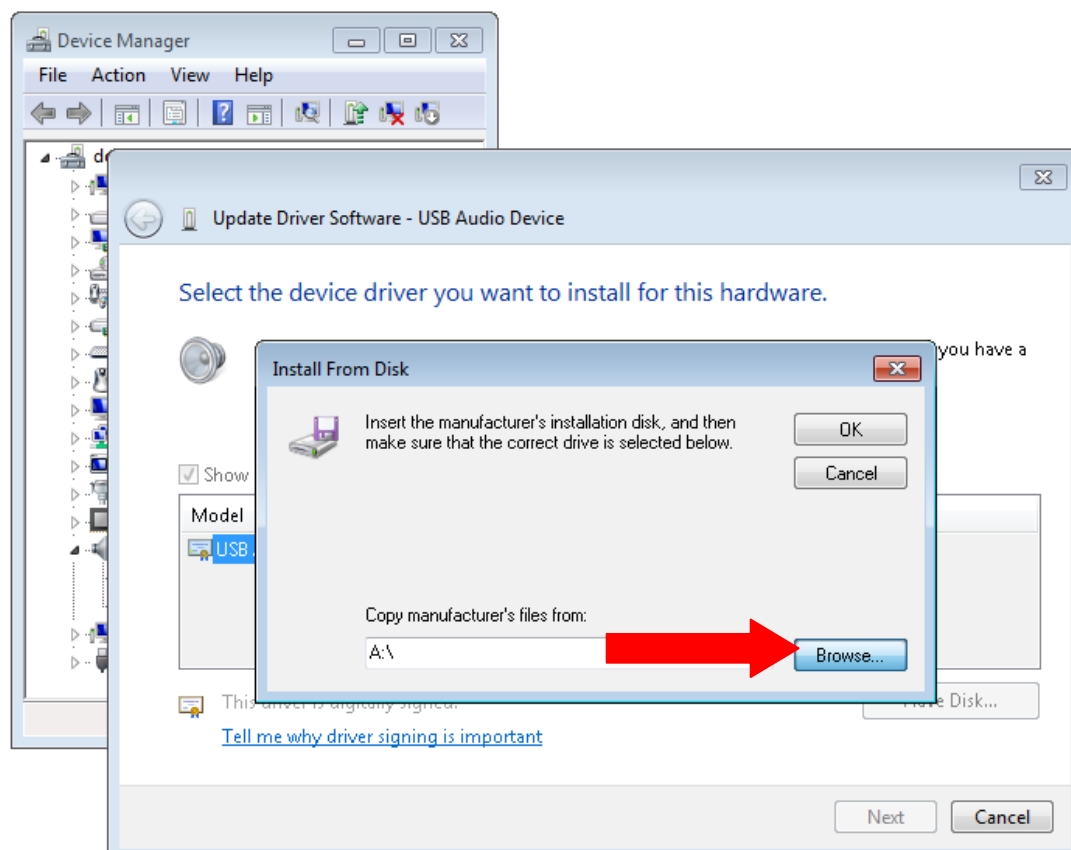
- 4 Select “**Browse my computer for driver software**”.



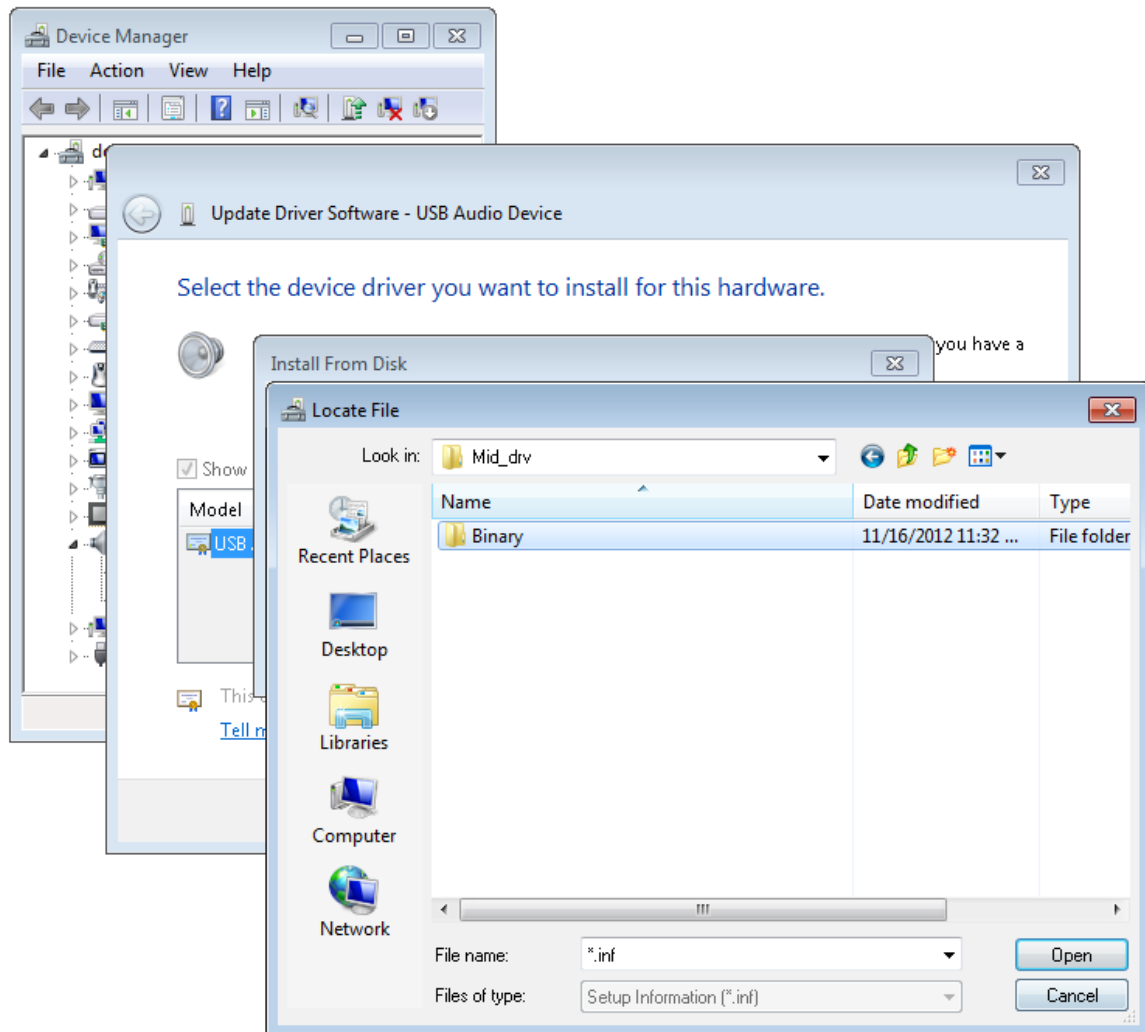
5 Click “**Have Disk...**”.



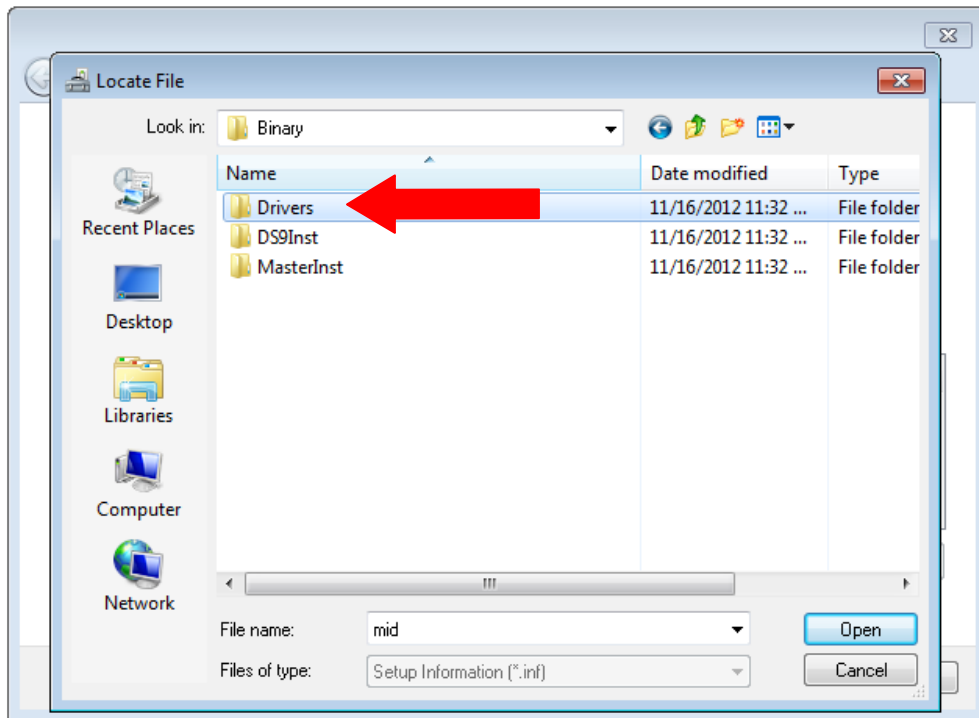
6 In the next screen, click “**Browse...**”.



- 7 Browse to the driver package on your desktop (1) and open the folder “Mid_drv” (2). Then select the folder “Binary” (3).



8 Search for folder “**Drivers**”.



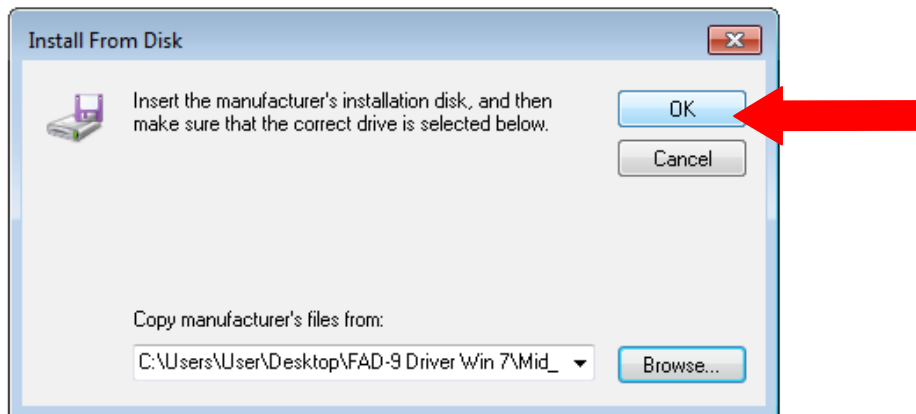
9 Select folder “**driver**”.



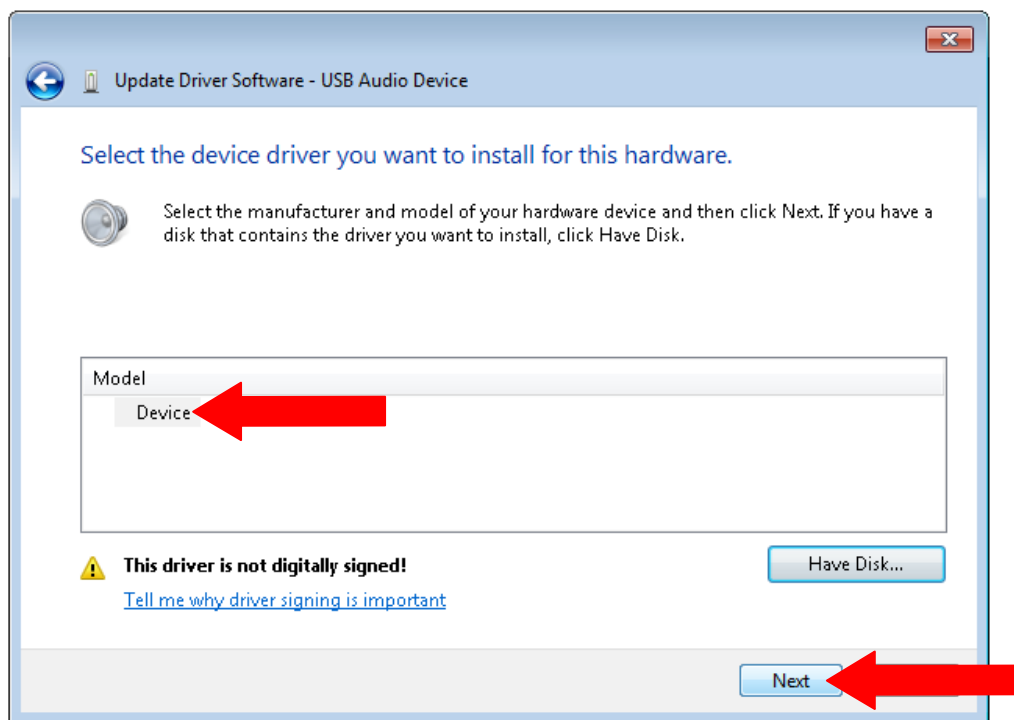
10 In the folder, open the file “mid”.



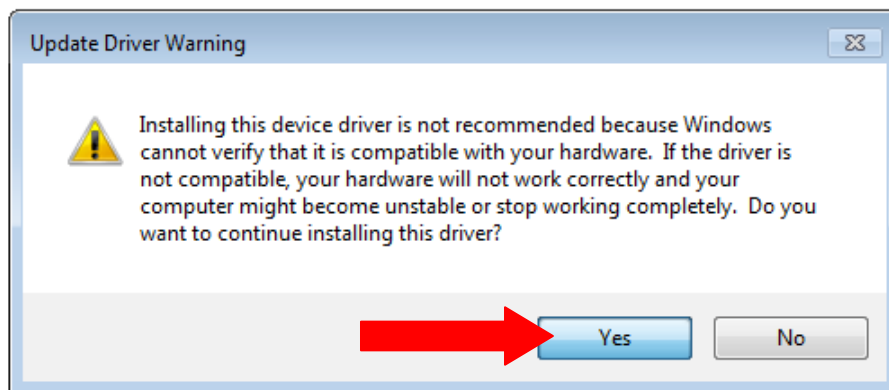
11 Confirm with “OK”.



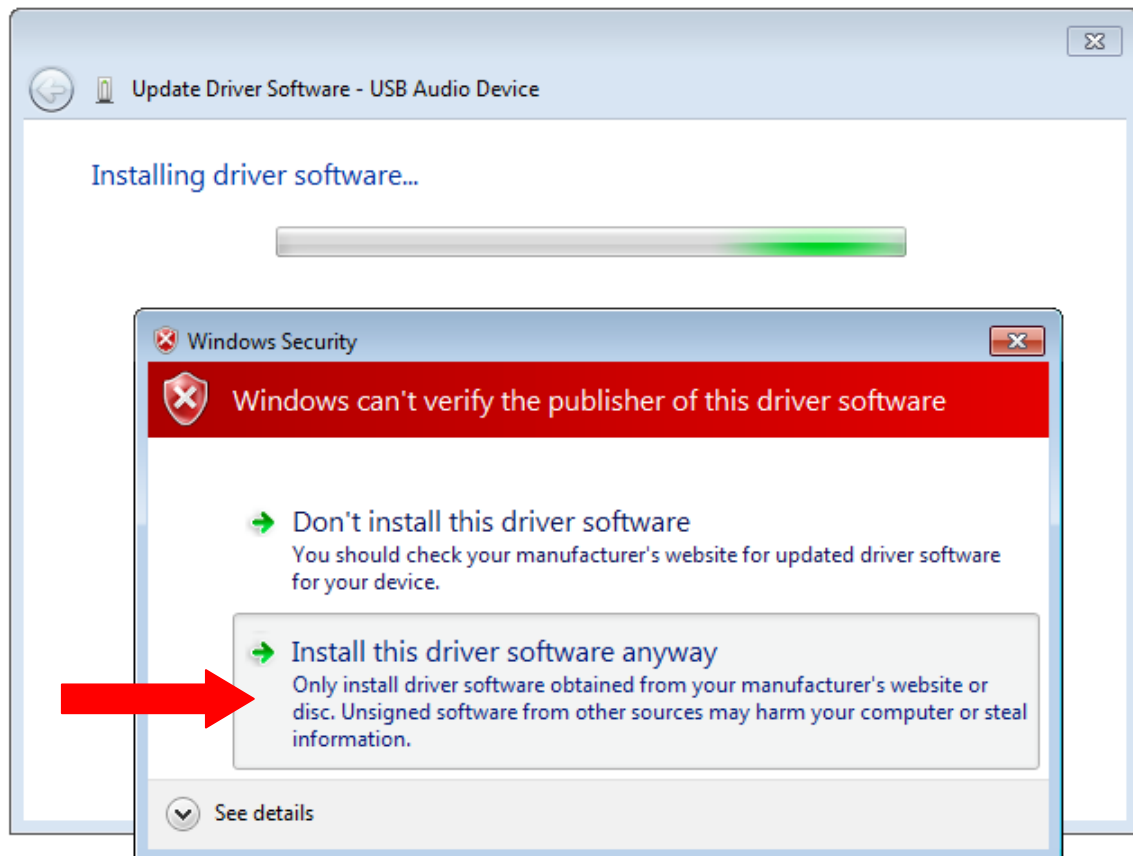
12 Click **“Device”** and then **“Next”**.



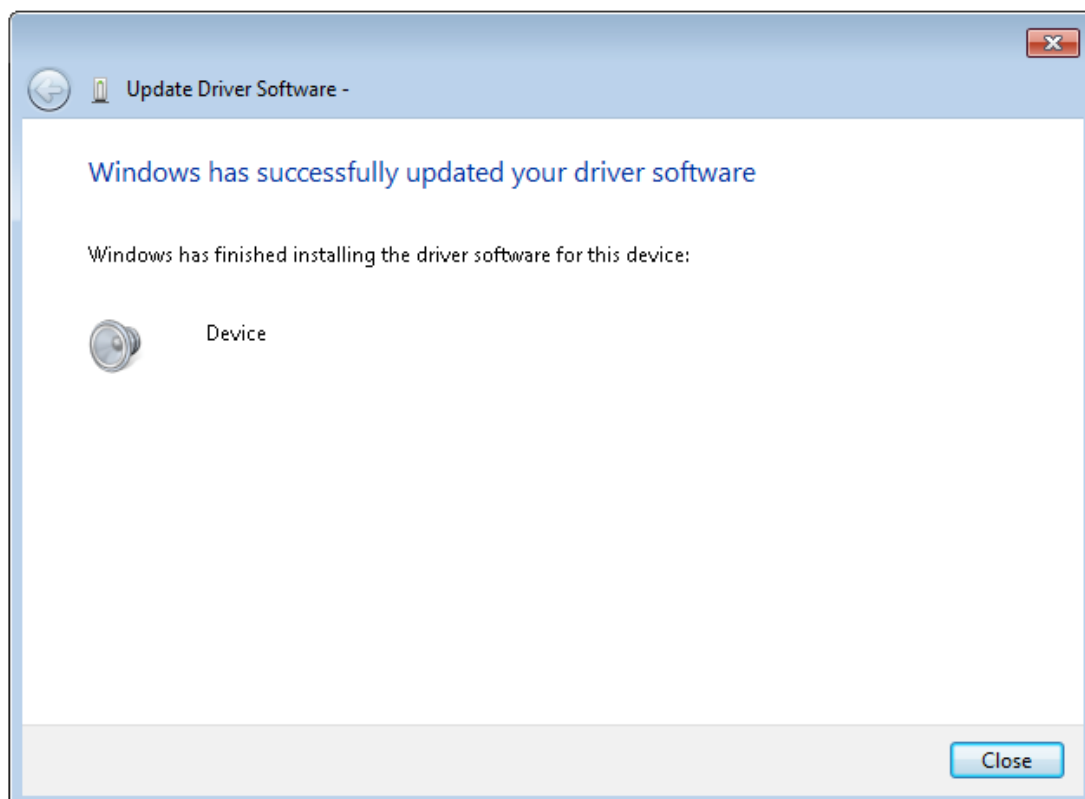
13 Ignore the warning and confirm the installation with **“Yes”**.



14 Confirm once more with: **“Install this driver software anyway”**.



Windows will inform you once it has successfully installed the driver software.



- 15** The controller is now ready for operation and fully functional.
